

2026 EAGLE CLASSIC Team Invitation



Hello, Coaches!

AYSO Region 23, extends an invitation to all Boys and Girls teams in divisions U10-U14 to participate in the 2026 Eagle Classic

Scope: AYSO Invitational – open to AYSO teams only from all Sections.

When: U10 – U14 Boys/Girls Friday (for local teams), Saturday, and Sunday, April 24 - April 26, 2026 (We play rain or shine)

Where: The tournament will be held at Schabarum Regional Park Soccer Complex, 17250 E. Colima Rd, Rowland Heights, CA 91748 and Newton Middle school, 15616 Newton St. Hacienda Heights, CA 91745.
No pets are allowed at fields.

Who: AYSO boys and girls teams in age divisions: U-14 (11v11) 15 players max. U-12 (9v9) 12 players max. and U-10 (7v7) 10 players max. All players must be registered to play in the AYSO 2025 primary season. Eligibility based on age as of December 31, 2025. AYSO Guest players will be allowed (3 maximum per team). Co-ed teams will be accepted in boys' divisions only.

What: Pool play tournament. Each team will be scheduled 3 games in pool play. The top teams will advance, based on Rules of competition, to the medal round on Sunday. All pool play games will be as follows: U10 – 2 - 20 min halves; U12 - 2 - 25 min halves & U14 - 2 - 30 min halves

Why: The purpose of the Eagle Classic Tournament is to provide the players, parents and coaches of teams interested a safe, fair, and fun venue to continue their soccer experience during the spring. Revenue from the Eagle Classic Tournament will be implemented to provide equipment and other resources to the players and coaches of Region 23.

Awards: All players and head coach coaches per team will receive an Eagle Classic Tournament pin. T-shirts will be given to those who apply and return t-shirt form by **April 5, 2026**. Championship Head Coaches will receive a trophy. All semi-finalists and finalists will receive medals.

Entry Fee, Refunds: \$625 for U-14, \$600 for U-12, and \$575 for U-10. A full refund will be issued if tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is given. Within 30 days of the tournament, we will only issue a refund if a replacement team can be found, less any cost to register that replacement team.

Referee Fee, Refunds: \$350, refundable within 14 days of the tournament, if referee assignments have been completed. Each team is asked to provide a qualified 3-person referee team to cover 3 games during the tournament.

Rules: A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website.

Acceptance: The application deadline is April 5, 2026. Incomplete applications will be returned. All teams will be notified within 48 hrs. of the application deadline as to their status. Accepted teams will be posted on the AYSO 23 Regional website, which will serve as notification of acceptance. Regions will not be permitted to switch or change teams once accepted. All teams not accepted will be notified via email within 48 hours of the respective division application deadline. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their complete application returned or to be placed on the waiting list.

How: Team entry applications and all necessary forms are available on the tournament website. Please send 1 Region check that covers both the Entry and Referee fees, along with the Team Application, Team Roster, and Referee Information and T-shirt order from to the Tournament Registrar address below. Regional commissioner must sign application and team roster. Appropriate referee administrator must sign referee information form. See referee form for details.
